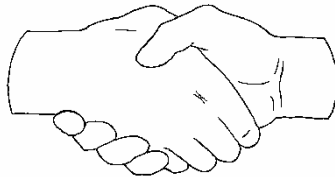

NOWHERE BETWEEN TWO SOMEWHERE'S

*At that time His voice shook the earth, but now He has promised, 'Once more I will shake not only the earth but also the heavens.' The words 'once more' indicates the removing of what can be shaken—that is, **created things**—so that what cannot*

be shaken may remain. [Heb. 12:26].

If you are old enough, you may remember a popular rock 'n roll song entitled *Shake, Rattle and Roll*. You may have danced to the song and even gone through all the shakes

and gyrations that the song suggests. You may have thought at the moment, 'Man, I'm having the time of my life!' However, it wasn't until later in your life that you truly discovered what is 'true shaking.'

At some point in our lives, everyone experiences shaking. It maybe the loss of a job, trouble in your church, or some form of family difficulty. I know I do not have to convince you, for we know all too well what it means to go through shaking in our lives.

A few short years ago, I went through a major shaking. It had to do with my ministry. The difficulty I was facing in the ministry was a place I had been several times before, but never quite like this one. It was here in this place of unbelievable shaking that God did a miraculous transformation in my life and ministry. The change in my life has not only had a profound effect on me, but it has also affected many others in ways I could have never imagined.

Like myself, many of you have a dialogue going on inside of you that goes something like this: *There is this thing God has called me to do, but in my current condition I am not capable of accomplishing it. I lack the training, talent, know how, ability (fill in your own argument). I continue to collide with the same problem. It is so far beyond me. I can never see it happening. Does this sound familiar?*

The truth is, we have all heard some form of this argument going on inside of ourselves. But if we believe God has called us and put something inside of us to do, then how do we overcome the argument and the seeming contradiction we feel between what we are called to do and our current reality?

WELCOME to ***The Hallway of Nowhere between Two Somewheres***. The Hallway of Nowhere between Two Somewheres is the place where God takes us from our last significant somewhere and transforms us so we can go to our next significant somewhere. Entrance into this hallway is always precipitated by some form of shaking in our lives. Here in this place of seeming darkness, difficulty, and disorientation,

God begins to reorder our lives. It wasn't until Moses was on the backside of a dark and lonely desert hallway, in complete disorientation, that God began to change his perception of what was possible. Remember, Moses had a good argument too, why he could not do what God was calling him to do!



In Hebrews 12:27 we read, *The words 'once more' indicate the removing of what can be shaken—that is, created things—so that what cannot be shaken may remain.* The word **removing** in Hebrews 12:27 is the Greek word *metathesis*. *Meta* means **to change, or movement**. *Thesis* means **a statement laid down to be argued about, a proposition, a position, or a stance**. Here in

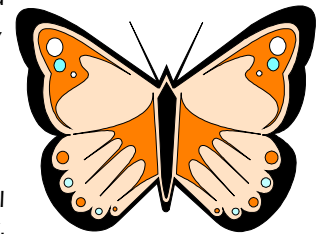
the Hallway of Nowhere between Two Somewheres is the place where everything that can be shaken is shaken, in or-

der that God can change our **perception** of what we see being possible. **Perception is reality!** Whether or not my perceptions are true, does not matter. If I perceive something to be true, I **act** as if it is true. Therefore, my perceptions determines my conceptions! This is one reason, as I stated, why I kept coming to this same problem time and again. I kept giving birth to what I perceived to be true.

For many, we have listened to the father of lies and his argument about our limitations. But here in this hallway,

as we are shaken, God changes the argument on the inside of us to line up with His position. God had to shake Moses free from his rod of the past. As he threw down his rod of the past, he could then pick up the rod to his future. As we are shaken, we let go of our limitations and false perceptions. As we let go of the **created things**, God moves us into an open-ended future full of potential. As we let go, we enter a realm where ALL THINGS ARE POSSIBLE, regardless of our circumstances. Like Moses, we pick up our rod and point it toward our future, **and make a way out of the way!**

As I close, think about the butterfly. What was he before he was a butterfly? He was a caterpillar, a creeping, crawling, and for some, frightening worm. Inside of himself is the strange desire to do something that he cannot do — FLY! But he takes one look at himself and argues, *I'm just a worm, and in my current condition it is impossible for me to fly. I want to fly, but how can I?* But after a while another argument ensues. The argument is this: his Creator instilled into his nature the desire and ability to fly. So, he is compelled to climb up a tree as high as he can. Once there, **he goes out on a limb**. Once out on this limb, he weaves himself inside of a dark, but necessary cocoon. There in the complete darkness, out of eyesight, the power of transformation goes to work on the structure of the caterpillar to change him. After a season in darkness and struggle, he breaks out of the cocoon a beautiful butterfly.



I believe we can fly! I believe we can touch the sky! We think about it night and day! Spread our wings and fly away! TODAY, **The Hallway of Nowhere** can be your doorway to an open-ended future!

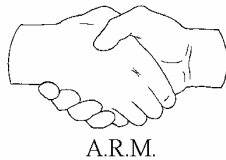

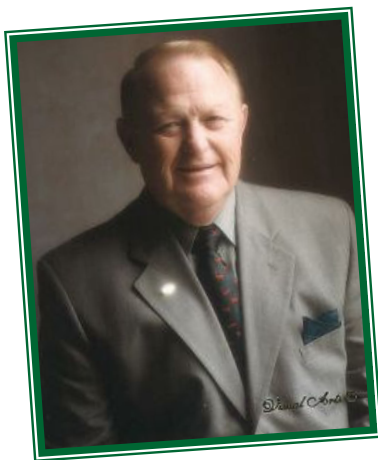
